

## RECERTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL BASELINE SURVEY

for  
MILITARY FAMILY HOUSING  
Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma

### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

Altus Air Force Base (AAFB) is located in Jackson County in southwestern Oklahoma, approximately 140 miles southwest of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The Air Force proposes to privatize military family housing (MFH) at AAFB. To support this action, an Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) was prepared in July 2002 to document the environmental conditions.


### 2.0 VISUAL INSPECTION

Due to the time lapse between completion of the EBS and issuing a request for privatization proposals, these facilities were resurveyed on 30 March 2004. Mr. James E. Bellon, of the 97 CES conducted a visual inspection of the subject MFH to determine current environmental conditions. There was no evidence of changes from the visual inspection conducted for the July 2002 EBS.


### 3.0 RECERTIFICATION
